Thermal camera purchase process



1 Export license application for thermal cameras

This document guides you through the process of purchasing thermal cameras and gives you an overview of the required documents.

To purchase the DINION IP thermal 8000 or MIC IP fusion 9000i camera, Bosch requires several mandatory documents, since the thermal cameras are Dual-Use products classified with ECCN and EU Export Control List Number 6A003 or ECCN 6A993.

Bosch uses a US origin core component in these cameras which may require a US re-export license and / or EU export license..

US re-export license application

For the US re-export license application, we need the US End-User statement filled in by the end-user. This document will be handed over to US Department of Commerce together with the license application form and the Bosch Product Specification (Product datasheet). Requirement based on US Export Administration Regulations (EAR).

EU export license application

For the EU export license application, we need the EU End-User statement to be completed by the end-user. By requirement of Dutch authorities, this document must be legalized by local chamber of commerce or similar authority in the country of the end-user. The legalized document will be handed over to the "Douane Belastingsdienst" and the Department of Foreign Affairs of The Netherlands together with the license application form and our Product Specification (Product datasheet). Requirement based on EU Legal Regulation Nr. 428/200.

Details for which set of documents is required depends on the situation, see table on the next page. Most of the documents may be arranged upfront, End User Statement (EUS), Consignee statement and Questionnaire. There may be additional questions raised by the authorities during the application process. At the end of the process a set of conditions formulated in the "Riders & Conditions" document has to be signed by the end user in order to complete the license application and deliver the product.

End User Statement (EUS) is always required at the same time you place your purchase order with Bosch. It contains information about the End-User, Usage (civil / non-civil) and exact product number (Commercial Type Number). This document needs to be filled-in and signed by the end-user on the end-user's letterhead.

Difference between Military and Civil Use:

Civil End Use does NOT include any national armed services (army, navy, marine, air force, or coast guard), as well as the national guard and national police, government intelligence or reconnaissance organizations, or any person or entity whose actions or functions are intended to support "military end-uses" including but not limited to Intelligence, reconnaissance, or surveillance systems suitable for supporting military operations.
